

## **INFORMATION FOR CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION**

*May apply if you have been a lawful permanent resident for at least 5 years and at least 18 years old; or permanent resident for at least 3 years and at least 18 years old, if you are married to a U.S. Citizen. To be able to have the test in another language you must be at least 50 years of age and at least 20 years with permanent resident card; or at least 55 years of age and at least 15 years with permanent resident card.*

### **YOU NEED:**

- Your legal name
- Name as it appears exactly on your Permanent Resident Card
- Other names you have used
- Social Security Number
- Date of birth and country of birth
- Citizenship information of parents
- Current marital status; if married: name of spouse, date of birth, date of marriage, SSN, PRC #, if became a US Citizen date and place.
- Home address, mailing address, & telephone number
- Information about your criminal record
- Address and dates where you have lived in the past 5 years
- List of employment from the past 5 years, name, address and dates, or if student, the name of the schools for the past 5 years, names, address and dates
- Dates you have traveled outside of the U.S for the past 5 years
- If you or/and your current spouse have been married before: name of ex-spouse, date of birth, date of marriage and date of divorce.
- Information about your children: name, date of birth, country of birth, PRC #, and address.
